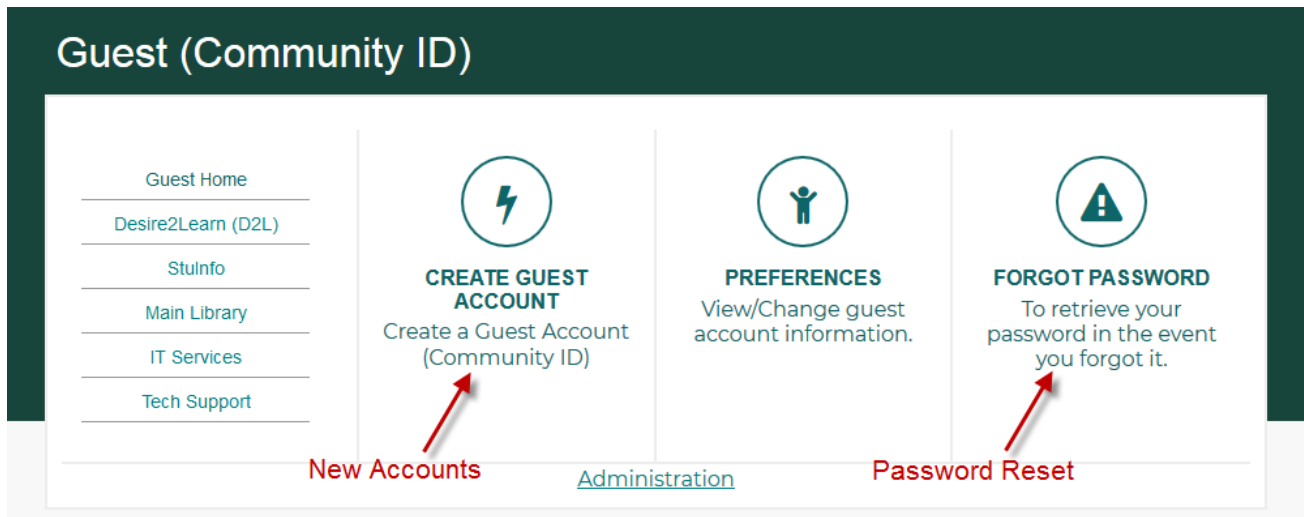


Instructions for completing Safety Training for Non-NSCL/FRIB Personnel

- 1) Create an MSU Community ID at: <https://community.idm.msu.edu/>



Those individuals that have already created a Community ID can log in with the user name and password that was already created at <https://d2l.msu.edu>. If you have a new email address, your Community ID will NOT change. Simply update your email through D2L and continue to log in with your old Community ID.

D2L has up to 48 hours to process your Community ID account. This means that the Safety Office may not be able to add you to the class for 48 hours. Please plan accordingly.

- 2) Complete setup of new MSU Community ID which will be sent to your email (new accounts only)
